How are we making Somerby even better?



1. We will improve children's love for writing.

We will do this by:

- starting each English lesson with a Grammar Challenge to secure fundamental skills
- introducing "journalling" to practise applying skills and knowledge learnt
- building on new vocabulary and helping children to remember topic based vocabulary previously learnt
- 3. We will ensure reading is at the heart of all we do, keeping the profile of reading high.

We will do this by:

- ensuring phonics and reading is led well across the school
- ensuring a consistent approach to Guided Reading, offering training for staff
- ensuring children reading below age expectation receive daily intervention
- exposing children to a wide range of genres

2. We will continue to enhance the quality of teaching and learning across all subjects.

We will do this by:

- creating a consistent approach to assessing the quality of teaching and learning in foundation subjects
- ensuring subject leaders monitor their subjects by observing, book looks and gaining pupil voice
- working collaboratively with subject leaders across the Trust to share best practice and moderate
 - 4. We will continue to support children with special educational needs to make better than expected progress.

We will do this by:

- ensuring personalised targets suit their needs and/or match their EHCP
- ensuring interventions are monitored for impact
- ensuring targets are reviewed after each assessment period
- ensuring parents are regularly kept informed with progress
- 5. We will aim to achieve SILVER AWARD status for Mental Health Award:

We will do this by:

- delivering mental health training to all stakeholders
- provide a specific area in our library where children can access resources to support positive mental health
- to ensure staff wellbeing is strong
- to ensure concerns are raised early and early intervention offered

6. We will continue to strengthen links with parents and carers.

We will do this by:

- continuing to listen and act upon "Parent Voice"
- offering workshops for parents to support children further: phonics, mental health, attendance, transition
- working collaboratively with FOAKS to raise money to improve outcomes for children.
- maintaining excellent communication with all stakeholders.
